

BY-LAW NO. 76

Effective October 18, 2005

Adopted August 11, 2005

Ministerial Approval: October 3, 2005

The Municipality of Chester has a Registry of all currently designated heritage properties in the Municipality, maintained by the Clerk and located in Community Development Department.

This By-Law also outlines the criteria for the *Heritage Advisory Committee*; however, as of 2011, the Heritage Advisory Committee's roles were assumed by the Municipal and Village Planning Advisory Committees. These two Committees advise Council on matters concerning designation, alteration or demolition of a Municipal Heritage Property.

If a property is to be added to the Registry, Committees have to file a specific form with the Clerk, and they, in turn, must file with the Registry of Deeds and send a copy to each registered owner of the heritage property.
