

BY-LAW NO. 132

Effective April 25, 1994

Adopted April 25, 1994

Simply, this By-Law says that no one is allowed to loiter in the Municipality of Chester. Loitering means standing around, lingering or hanging about on or around the entrances of buildings or on roads, streets or sidewalks UNLESS they have a good reason to do so.

Violation of this By-Law could earn a fine between \$50 and \$500, and if unpaid, imprisonment between five and thirty days.

This summary is meant to simplify the related By-Law and in NO WAY replaces the actual By-Law. In the event that the By-Law is contravened, all terms listed in the By-Law will take precedence over this Summary.
